

Rural Addressing

Rural Addressing is a standardized system which assigns an address to rural properties throughout the County. This system will allow a location to be easily identified and found by emergency response personnel such as police, fire and ambulance services, along with other local service and utility providers, residents and non-residents.

Standard Rules:

- Basic grid is derived from township and range roads
- 40 meter intervals
- Numbers increase to the north and west
- Odd numbers are on the south and east sides
- Even numbers are on the north and west sides
- Address numbers have a maximum of 6 digits

Example showing a typical address on a Township or Range Road:

55019 TWP RD 841

- **55** (reference road is Range Road 55)

- **019** (interval 19 in 40 metre grid west from Range Road 55 –

Odd number indicates location on south side of road)
