

BYLAW NO. 272-22

BEING A BYLAW OF CLEAR HILLS COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING AN INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN WITH THE VILLAGE OF HINES CREEK

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, provides that two or more councils of municipalities that have common boundaries must, by each passing a bylaw, adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan to include those areas of land lying within the boundaries of the municipalities as they consider necessary; and

WHEREAS, Clear Hills County and the Village of Hines Creek have agreed to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Clear Hills County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT, this Bylaw may be cited as the "Clear Hills County – Village of Hines Creek Intermunicipal Development Plan".
2. THAT, the "Clear Hills County – Village of Hines Creek Intermunicipal Development Plan", attached to this Bylaw as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.
3. THAT, this Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended from time to time.
4. THAT, If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
5. THAT, Bylaw No. 39 is hereby rescinded.
6. THAT, his bylaw shall come into force and effect when it receives third and final reading and is duly signed.

READ a second time this 13th day of December, 2022.

READ a third time this 13th day of December, 2022.
